**Additional intervention put into place ensured that in 2014/15:**

- 5% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved level 4+ in reading writing and GPS tests at the end of Key stage 2.
- 5% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved level 4+ in maths at the end of Key stage 2.
- 7% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made two or more levels progress in reading, writing and maths.
- 14% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made three or more levels progress in reading and writing

**Additional intervention put into place ensured that in 2013/14:**

- 100% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved level 4+ in reading and maths tests at the end of Key stage 2.
- 7% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved level 4+ in writing at the end of Key stage 2.
- 100% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made two or more levels progress in reading and writing.
- 100% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made two or more levels progress in maths
- 71% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made three or more levels progress in reading
- 29% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made three or more levels progress in writing
- 29% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium made three or more levels progress in maths
- 3% of the children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved a level 6 in maths
